On the day of arrival to the sailing site, please bring a *Student Registration Form* for each participating student and the remaining fee amount according to the number of students attending. It is best that teachers initially collect the money from students and the school pay for the remaining number of students with a *single payment*. Students who do not have their registration form *fully* completed and submitted cannot go on the water.

It is expected that at least one supervising teacher remain with the class for the entire session and they are welcome to join the coaches in the coach boat or paddle a kayak.

What students should bring: They will need to bring appropriate layered clothing for the weather. They **will** get wet at least up to the waist. Note temperatures on the water are often much cooler than on land. A windbreaker jacket is highly recommended no matter what the weather is like. Bring a full change of clothes and close toed shoes that can also get wet and won't fall off if they end up swimming (ie – old sneakers, "aquasocks", etc.) Hat and sunscreen are recommended for sunny days. BC Sailing will provide lifejackets. Please also bring an adequate lunch and snack.

Cancellation Policy: Please inform BC Sailing of cancellations as soon as possible. A cancellation fee of \$200 will be charged if cancelled within 14 days of the date of the booking. There are no refunds once a course has begun, however, exceptions to this rule may be made if cancellation is due to injury or illness. Such exceptions are at the discretion of BC Sailing. If less than the minimum number of students show up to the sailing day, you will be charged the equivalent of the minimum number of students enrolling.
