

ITEM 5: Rules review.

- a. Jason Vandergaag is working with IT Bob Brunius to implement and upgrade the current PHRF BC system to accommodate the new rules as outlined in the Fall'15 Minutes. Full testing is expected shortly with implementation for 2017. The current PHRF BC database has been updated and will be forwarded to Jason immediately.
- b. The PHRF BC application form and Rules will be updated mid December to reflect the new spinnaker rules.

ITEM 6: New business.

- a. Roger Kibble will research appropriate teleconferencing options for upcoming Handicapper Committee meetings.
- b. John Windas proposed a re-evaluation of sport boat handicaps in relation to inboard cruising boats. It was noted that this topic is currently being discussed globally and across a multitude of rating systems. It was also noted that there may be an exaggeration of this difficulty in smaller fleets where rating spreads are well above the recommended +/-3sec where a PHRF system can be fairly relied upon. Considering the low cost and the simplicity of a one number system it is quite interesting to note how close most boats correct out over a series or a season.

ITEM 6: 2016 PHRF BC Fall Appeals review.

The Appeals listed for hearing at SNSYC on Oct 29/16 were reviewed for input from Handicappers who would not be able to attend the Appeals hearings.
