ITEM 6: 2016 PHRF BC Spring Appeals hearings - 1930hrs.

1. Paul Faget, Port Madison YC, appealing Left Coast Dart, #2, “Ogopogo”
Decision: Base boat rating of 120 “T” to be assigned based on yacht’s specs/ speed potential/designer/results and class history. Yacht to be placed on the Watchlist.
2. Mike Broser, Pt Roberts YC, appealing Hunter 35.5, #6161, “Diversion”
Decision: No change in base boat rating at this time. Handicapper Al Whitfield will work with owner to canvas PtRobertsYC fleet for competitor input.
3. Roger Kibble, SISC, appealing Aphrodite 101, #CAN109, “Electra”
Decision: Base boat rating assignment to be 141 based on results provided and to reflect code 3 jib adjustment NW to BC for self tacking jib size limitation.
