Programs offered by BC sailing include:

Learn to Sail

Includes all CYA Learn to Sail and Race programs, PCOC, and the Mobile Optimist Sailing School.

Learn to Cruise

BC Sailing delivers the manuals, materials and certification for the CYA Learn to Cruise program offered through several schools in BC.

Instructor and Coach Training

All instructor development clinics and teaching aids, such as course manuals are offered through BC Sailing.

Racing

BC Sailing supports Regional Training Centres, National Team programs, the BC Sailing Circuit, provincial and regional camps and clinics and the BC, Western Canada and Canada Summer Games Teams.

PHRF BC

PHRF ratings for keelboats in BC.

Race Management and Judging

BC Sailing offers programs in race management and judging, which help clubs to run quality racing programs.

BC High School Credits Program

BC Sailing offers the most comprehensive and extensive BC High School credits program for all race officials, racers and coaches.

about Cascadia Yacht Club

The Cascadia Yacht Club was formed by BC Sailing for individuals wishing to participate in sailing events in BC, but do not have access to a local recognized yacht club. The Cascadia Yacht Club is open to all sailors in BC, including both dinghy and keelboat racers.

The membership fee for the Cascadia Yacht Club is \$30 per year. The membership is valid from January 1 to December 31. Joining the Cascadia Yacht Club also includes BC Sailing and CYA membership. The Board of Directors for the Cascadia Yacht Club is the current BC Sailing Executive.

why join Cascadia

In order to race in Canada, each competitor must show Canadian Yaching Association (CYA) membership. Members of yacht clubs recognized by BC Sailing are members of both BC Sailing and CYA. However, not all yacht clubs or sailing clubs are recognized, and some clubs have long waiting lists to become a member. Membership in the Cascadia Yacht Club provides BC Sailing and CYA membership.
