REASON FOR APPEAL:

The Hotfoot 27 rating was adjusted on 14 March 24 from 147 to 141, not because of an appeal, but because the handicapper committee just felt it should move. No results were quoted as justification, just an adjustment. This makes the Hotfoot 27 allegedly as fast as the Aphrodite 101 and faster than J/30s and C+C 33-2 etc, which is completely false. The Hotfoot 27 has a proven history of close boat for boat racing with the Martin 242 and Santa Cruz 27 with a slight advantage on the Moore 24 in less than 15 kts of wind. The Hotfoot 27 rating should return to 147 in order to foster fair and competitive racing.
