REASON FOR APPEAL:

Please provide a succinct outline of the reason for this appeal. Forward the completed Appeal Form to the BC Sailing Offices accompanied by a copy of your current PHRFBC Certificate, any supporting documentation including a list of owners who support your appeal, and a complete list of race results for the relevant season.

I would like to have the PHRF back to what the rating was in 2022 of 228 or a more reasonable rating not far from 228 for the following reasons:

- 1) The results in the local series are not conclusive for a change.
- 2) The reviews in the last 2 years do not include other Tanzer 26s so it has been Golf Handicapped, not reviewed as a class to verify that other skipper are supposedly performing.
- 3) BC Sailing PHRFs are higher for higher ratings compared to other regions and now Tanzer 26 is not close with similar boats in BC. Like other regions have similar ratings for similar boats.
- 4) Alleged NA average does not take on account that the different regions have their whole fleets shifted up or down, so even if corrected times are lower in BC it is because all other boats are also lower in BC. Also other regions use different A and B factors to calculate the corrected time affecting the ratio of how much corrected times change respect the rating.
Therefore NA average cannot be done directly looking at the number of the ratings and cannot be averaged directly.
